Library storytime travels to Peck Farm to reach 79 children & caregivers.



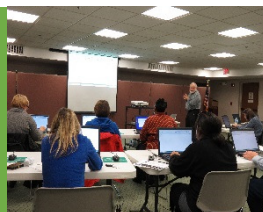
